
CURRENT SERMON SERIES:  
1<sup>ST</sup> CORINTHIANS

As we pause from the Three-Year Lectionary Cycle, our sermon series will follow the chronology of Paul's Epistles (the chart below shows the most widely agreed upon date orders of Paul's letter writing.) Last Sunday, we completed 2nd Thessalonians, and so today, we are beginning Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. The church in Corinth was founded by Paul on his second missionary journey (Acts 18:1). As usual, his ministry began in the synagogue, where he was assisted by two Jewish believers, Priscilla and Aquila, with whom he lived for a while and who were fellow tradesmen. Soon after, Silas and Timothy joined them, and Paul began preaching even more intensely in the synagogue. When most of the Jews resisted the gospel, he left the synagogue, but not before Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, his family, and many other Corinthians were converted (Acts 18:5-8).

Unable to fully break with the culture from which it came, the church at Corinth was exceptionally factional, showing its carnality and immaturity. Although the central thrust of this epistle is corrective of behavior rather than of doctrine, Paul gives important teaching on many doctrines that directly relate to the matters of sin and righteousness because, in one way or another, wrong living always stems from wrong belief.

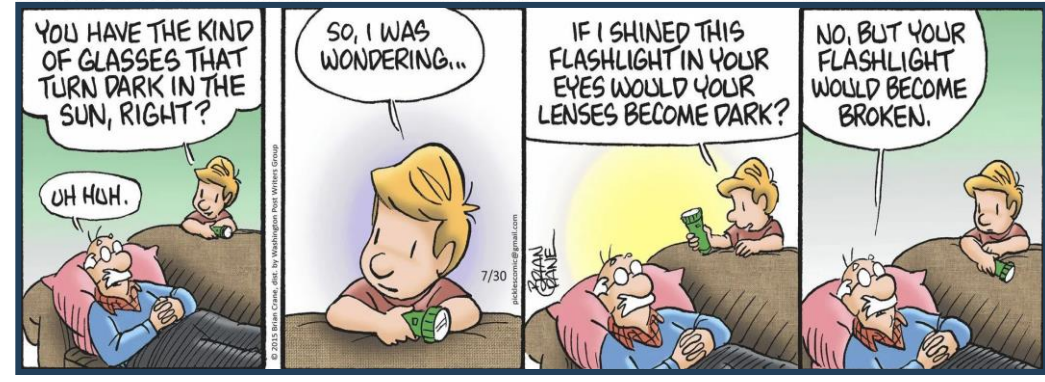

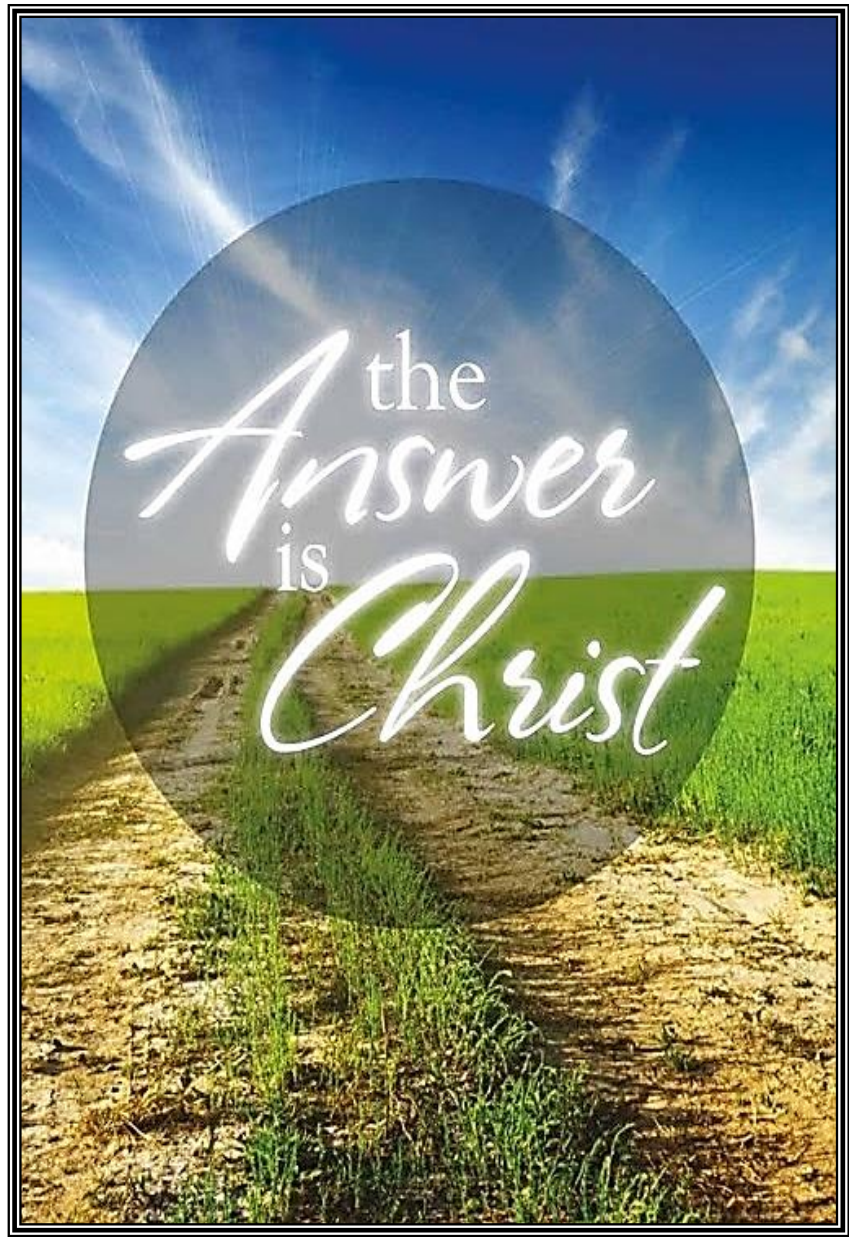
