HEIDELBERG CATECHISM
LORD'S DAY 15

QUESTION:

In the Apostles Creed we affirm that Christ
 "suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried..."
 What do we mean by the word "suffered"?

ANSWER:

We affirm that Christ sustained in his body and soul the
 wrath of God against the sin of the whole human race. This he did
 in order that, by his suffering as the only atoning sacrifice, he might
 deliver us, body, and soul, from eternal condemnation, and
 gain for us God's grace, righteousness, and eternal life.

QUESTION:

Why did Christ suffer "under Pontius Pilate" as his judge?

ANSWER:

So that he, though innocent, might be condemned by an earthly judge,
 and so free us from the severe judgment of God that was to fall on us.

QUESTION:

Is it significant that Christ was "crucified"
 instead of dying some other way?

ANSWER:

Yes, because scripture declares: Christ redeemed us from the
 curse of the law by becoming a curse for us – for it is written,
 "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"
