THE WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM

QUESTION 45

Which is the first commandment?

ANSWER:

The first commandment is: You shall have no other gods before me

QUESTION 46

What is required in the first commandment?

ANSWER:

The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

QUESTION 47

What is forbidden in the first commandment?

ANSWER:

The first commandment forbids the denial of, or failure to worship and glorify, the true God as God; and it forbids giving that worship and glory to any other which is due to God alone.



We Are Confessionally Reformed: We hold the doctrines of the Reformation without compromise and declare this freely before God and to the world in our confessions. These doctrines are summed up in what's been called "The Five Solas" (sola means alone).

- Sola Scriptura (Scripture Alone): We begin our discipleship with the conviction that the Bible is the inerrant, infallible Word of God. No belief or practice of our church should exist, save that it rests securely upon a "thus sayeth the Lord."
Soli Deo Gloria (For the Glory of God Alone) We believe that all of life is to be lived for the glory of God alone. In fact, we believe that we were created for that very purpose, to glorify God in all that we do, in all areas of life.
Solus Christus (By Christ's Work Alone are We Saved) We believe that we are saved by faith in Christ who is the sole mediator between God and man. John Calvin, one of the Reformed fathers, said in the Institutes of the Christian Religion, "Christ stepped in, took the punishment upon himself and bore the judgment due to sinners. With his own blood he expiated the sins which made them enemies of God and thereby satisfied him...we look to Christ alone for divine favor and fatherly love!"
Sola Gratia (Salvation Is by Grace Alone) A central theme of the Reformation was salvation by grace-the reformers returned to the biblical doctrine of salvation by grace through faith. We believe our righteous standing before God is imputed to us by grace because of the work of Christ Jesus our Lord.
Sola Fide (Justification Is by Faith Alone) The cry of the Reformation was 'justification by faith alone'. We believe that we are saved from our sins only because God, in His mercy and grace, has given us faith in Jesus Christ, our Savior. We are justified, made right before God, not by any good works that we do but only the gift of faith in what Christ has done for us. Even this faith is not a good work that saves us because it is also a gift from God, by His mercy.
Soli Deo Gloria (For the Glory of God Alone) We believe that all of life is to be lived for the glory of God alone. In fact, we believe that we were created for that very purpose, to glorify God in all that we do, in all areas of life.


