QUESTION 63  
Which is the fifth commandment?

QUESTION 64

. What is required in the fifth commandment?

QUESTION 65

. What is the promise added to the fifth commandment?

ANSWER:

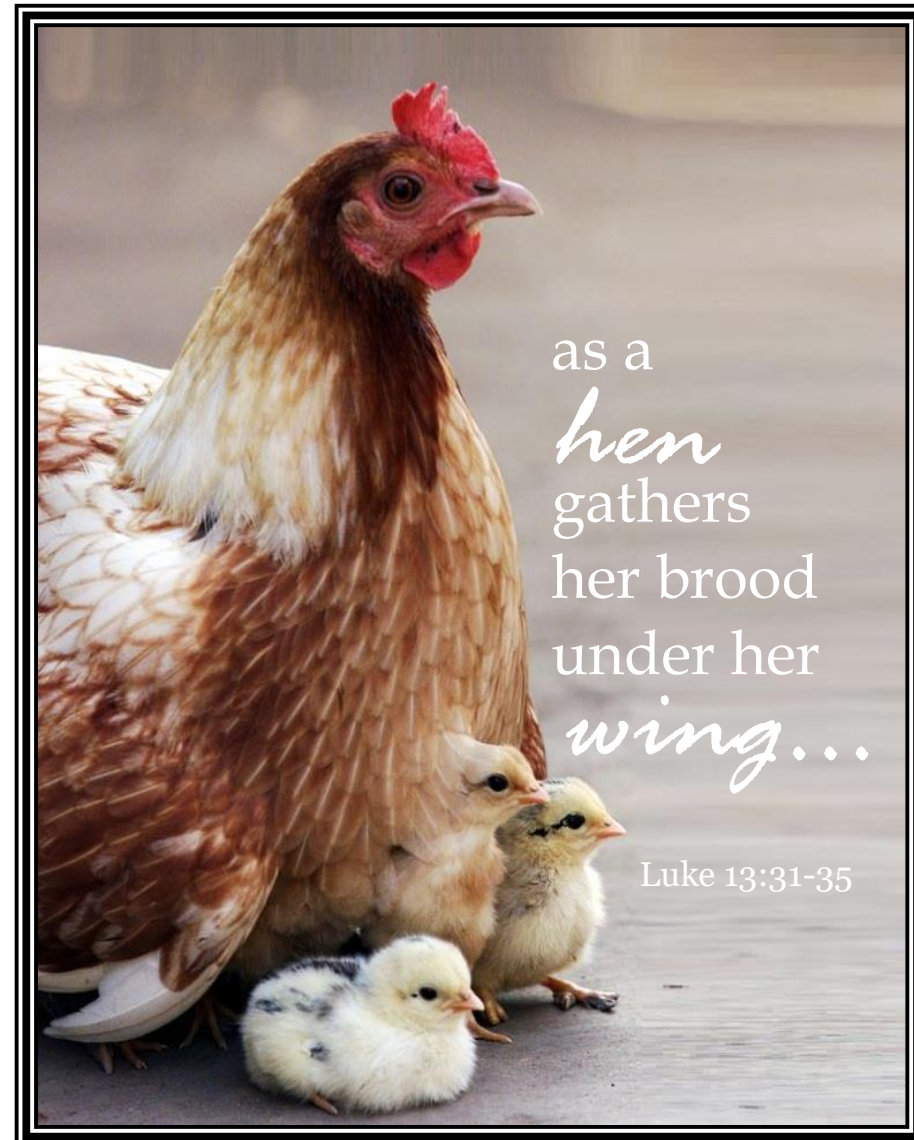
