**QUESTION 104**

. What do we pray for in the fourth petition of The Lord's Prayer?

**ANSWER:**

In the fourth petition, which is, "Give us this day our daily bread," we pray that by God's free gift we may receive a sufficient portion of the good things of this life and enjoy his blessing with them.

**4 Myths ABOUT  
5 POINT CALVINIST CHURCHES**

**Myth #1:** CALVINISTS DO NOT BELIEVE THAT THE GOSPEL IS FOR ALL.  
**FALSE:** The offer of the gospel is universal and God truly does command all to heed it. God's common grace extends to all men, and Jesus invites "whosoever will" to come.

**Myth #2:** CALVINISM DESTROYS EVANGELISM  
**FALSE:** Historically and Biblically there can be nothing further from the truth. In fact, some of the earliest missionaries were Calvinists. Romans Chapters 8-10 clearly tell us about how necessary it is to preach the Gospel. No one is beyond hope. We do not have the mind of God - so we do not know whom He has pre-ordained and we do not know at what point in time they will heed the call of repentance.

**Myth #3:** CALVINISM ENCOURAGES PRIDE  
**FALSE:** While pride may be a stumbling block for many people, Calvinism does not encourage prideful thinking. In fact, it's quite the opposite. We know that we are saved by Grace alone and not by our own efforts.

**MYTH #4:** CALVINISM TEACHES PEOPLE DON'T HAVE FREE WILL.  
**FALSE:** God allows us to make voluntary choices based on our preferences and unique character traits, but it is all done according to His Providence. We are not coerced but we do act out of necessity to God's predetermined will.







