

THE LESSONS FOR USE ON THE SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST ~ YEAR A Zechariah 9:9-12 • Psalm 145:8-15 Romans 7:15-25 • Gospel Focus: Matthew

WE AFFIRM THE FOLLOWING:

- The Holy Trinity of God Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

I heard someone say that we are a liturgical church, but I'm not sure what this means?

The word liturgy comes from the Greek language and means: "the work of the people." It is the things that God's people collectively do when they gather to worship. It refers to the words and actions, the songs and symbols that comprise the worship of the whole people of God. If you worship on Sunday, and you are actually participating - whatever you're doing is the "liturgy." It also means that the service of worship is done in a decent, orderly, and logical way. In summary - worship is "liturgical" if those doing the worshiping really understand who they are as the People of God and what they are doing. This liturgical style of worship makes the participants not passive spectators observing empty rituals or simply an audience listening to a musical performance but active participants in ascribing praise and devotion to the Triune God - the Lord of Heaven and earth.


