WHY ARE WE READING THE HEIDELBERG CATECHISM?

Catechism (from the Greek word catechesis) is simply instruction in the basic doctrines of the Christian faith. Instead of replacing or supplanting the role of the Bible in Christian education, catechism ideally serves as the basis for it. It is the Christian equivalent of looking at the box top of a jig-saw puzzle before one starts to put all of those hundreds of little pieces together. It is very important to look at the big picture and have it clearly in mind, before moving on to deeper truths. That being noted however, as Protestants we have always argued that creeds, confessions and catechisms are authoritative only in so far as they faithfully reflect the teaching of Holy Scripture.

"No human being can possibly come to Christ unless something happens that makes it possible for him to come. That necessary condition Jesus declares is that
