

WHY DO WE BELIEVE OUR CHURCH IS A TRUE CHURCH AND HOW DO YOU IDENTIFY A FALSE ONE?

The search for a church can be difficult and frustrating. If you pick up the Yellow Pages (if anyone still does that) and look under "Church," you are likely to confront a bewildering array of possibilities. But when it comes down to it, what should you be looking for in choosing a church? Your first concern should be that the church you attend be a "True Church." So how do you recognize a True Church?

The Protestant Reformers were clear in their answer to this question; the one True, Holy and Apostolic church is present where:

(1) the whole Word of God in the Old and New Testament is preached and taught; which leads to: >

(2) the Sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper being rightly administered; which can only happen when: >

(3) church discipline is faithfully exercised. This third mark requires the existence of qualified, godly, male leadership who provide a safe place for a Christian flock to grow in Christ and who can ward off any wolves who seek to destroy that flock (see Acts 20). Any assembly of people who are simply getting together to sing, hear a motivational speech and enjoy a time of fellowship, without the oversight and care of courageous and responsible leaders, does not constitute the gathering of a True Church.

In conclusion – unless all three of these marks exist, the True Church is not present (and you shouldn't be either), because, where these marks are absent, true holiness will be absent too....and that's important because God is always more concerned with a Church's corporate holiness than with our personal happiness.


