QUESTION:

According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

ANSWER

God requires that his justice be satisfied. Therefore, the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

> QUESTION: Can we make this payment ourselves?


ANSWER. Certainly not. Actually, we increase our debt every day.


