WHAT IS MAUNDY THURSDAY AND WHY DO WE OBSERVE IT WITH A WORSHIP SERVICE?

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

MAUNDY THURSDAY occurs just prior to Good Friday. It is the day when Jesus celebrated his final Passover with His disciples. Most notably, that Passover meal was when Jesus washed His disciples' feet in an extraordinary display of humility. He then commanded them to display the same humility towards each other. That is where the traditional name of the day comes from. The English word "Maundy" is a shortened form of the Latin word "*mandatum*," which means "command." Jesus and his disciples had just shared what we know as the Last Supper, and he was washing their feet when he said: "*A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another*" (John 13:34). This New Commandment raised the definition of love to a new and higher standard. Jesus sacrificially met His followers' most profound need---that of new spiritual life and the forgiveness of sins. He even loved His enemies, and He calls us to show love to those who don't appear to deserve it. Just as Jesus loved sinners "*to the end*" (John 13:1) when He had nothing to gain from them, so must we. The Bible says that there was nothing attractive about sinful humanity that drew Him to love us. God loved us while we were yet sinners (Romans 5:8). Salvation is not only a wonderful gift that protects us from the penalty that we deserve (Romans 6:23), but the work of Christ also infuses new life, grants spiritual strength, and motivates godly action in those who believe.

Many churches (like ours) observe Maundy Thursday with a Communion Service. This tradition helps Christians reflect on the sacrifice of Jesus while participating in his lasting memorial made of ordinary bread and wine as together, we commune spiritually with him "*in, with, and under*" the physical Elements by the power of the Holy Spirit. Please join us on the 28<sup>th</sup> and invite a friend.

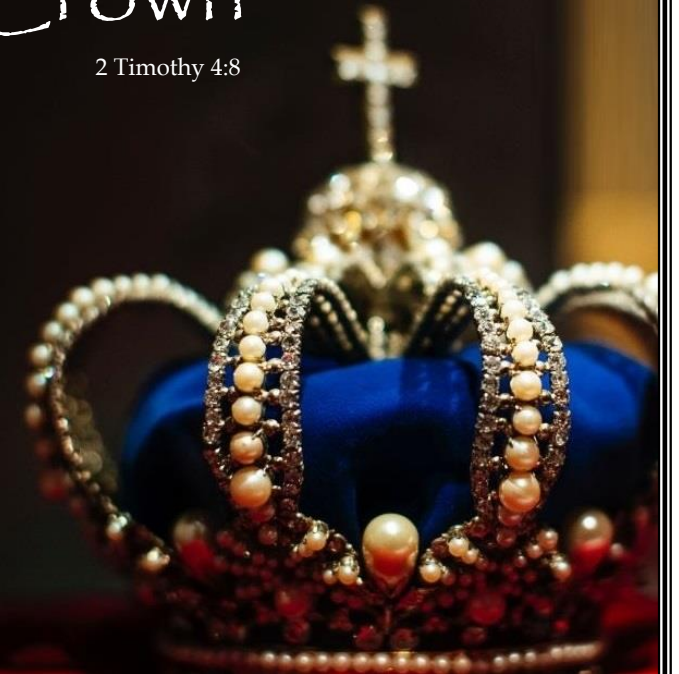
