2 Kings 5:1-15 • Psalm 111

HEIDELBERG CATECHISM
LORD'S DAY 8 & 9

QUESTION:
How are the Articles of the Apostles Creed divided?

ANSWER
The Articles are divided into three parts: God the Father and our creation; God the Son and our deliverance; and God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

QUESTION:
Since there is only one divine being, why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

ANSWER.
Because that is how God has revealed himself in his Word: as three distinct persons that are one, true, eternal God.

QUESTION:
What do you believe when you say, "I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth"?

ANSWER.
I believe that the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, created heaven and earth and everything in them, and that he still upholds and rules all things by his eternal counsel and divine providence.

I trust in God to provide whatever I need for body and soul, and that he will turn to my good whatever adversity he sends upon me in this sad world.

God is able to do this because he is Almighty God, and desires to do this because he is a faithful Father.

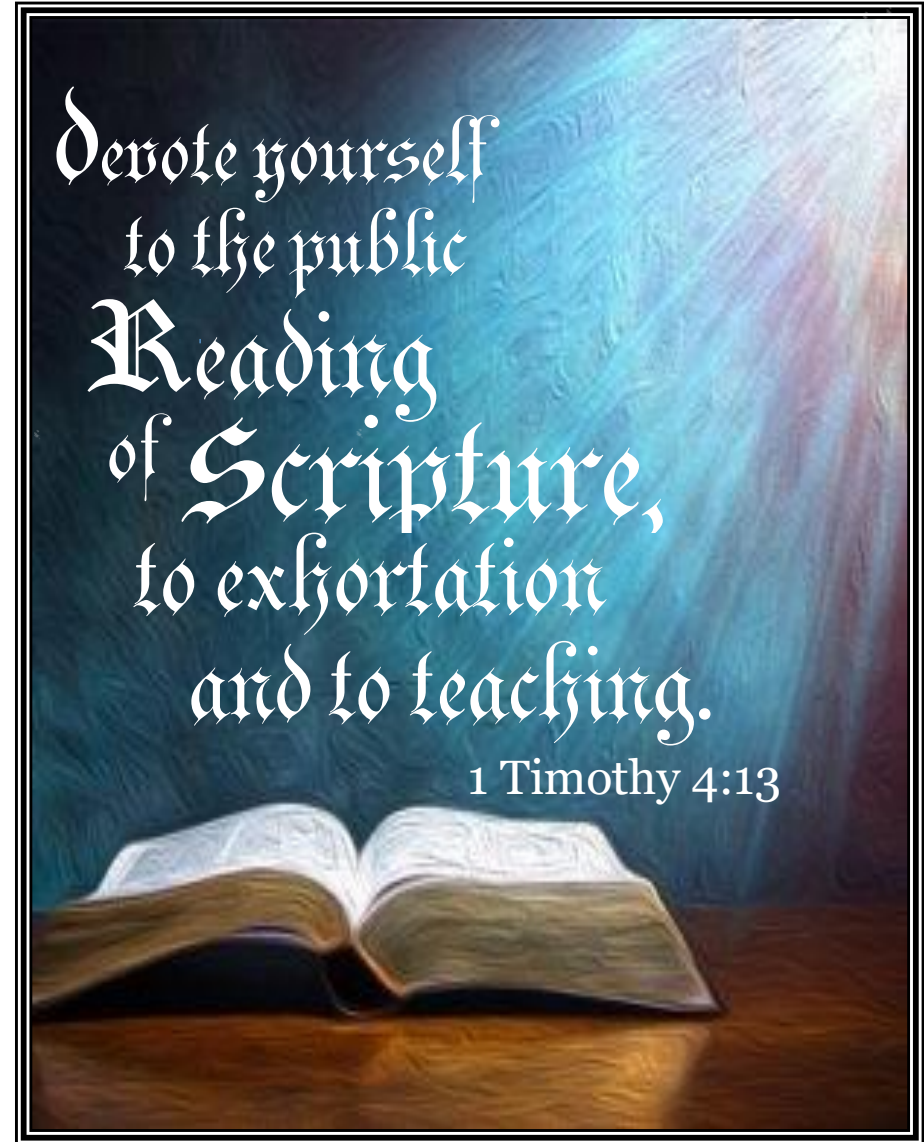
