SHORTER CATECHISM

QUESTION 79  
Which is the tenth commandment?


ANSWER:  
The tenth commandment is, "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor's."

QUESTION 80  
What is required in the tenth commandment?

ANSWER:  
The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a correct and charitable orientation of our spirit toward our neighbors and all that is theirs.

QUESTION 81  
. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?

ANSWER:  
The tenth commandment forbids all manner of discontentment with our own state, envying or grieving at the good state of our neighbors, and all excessive feelings and desires for anything that belongs to them.



If Christ has not been raised, the Church has nothing to say and no hope to offer. Jesus might have healed, fed, and taught, but none of it matters if He is still dead. Jesus might have made some people's lives a little better while he was here and left the rest of us with some good ideas to think about, but if He did not rise from the dead - then who cares? As Paul wrote in 1st Corinthians 15:19, "If all we get out of Christ is a little inspiration for a few short years, we are of all people most to be pitied."

But that's not the case at all. Jesus did rise from the dead, and because of that, death holds no more power over us, or the people we love. Because Jesus rose from the dead, the people we have "loved and lost" will rise too. Death is not the end of that person's story, and it won't be the end of ours. That's the difference the resurrection makes. Everything radiates out from this.

It's the resurrection that makes Jesus different from every other faith leader who has ever existed. It's the resurrection that makes Christianity different from every other religion that has ever existed, because God the Son became human, died, and rose again—and not just to show that he could, but for our redemption. The resurrection of Jesus is just the beginning and one day Jesus will return with a loud shout and a trumpet call and God will raise the dead again, and he will wipe every tear from our eyes.
