LECTIONARY READINGS FOR THE WEEK BEGINNING ON THE TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST 1 Kings 17:8-16 • Psalm 146
Hebrews 9:24-28 • Mark 12:13-17

We Affirm the Following:

- The Holy Trinity of God Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.




