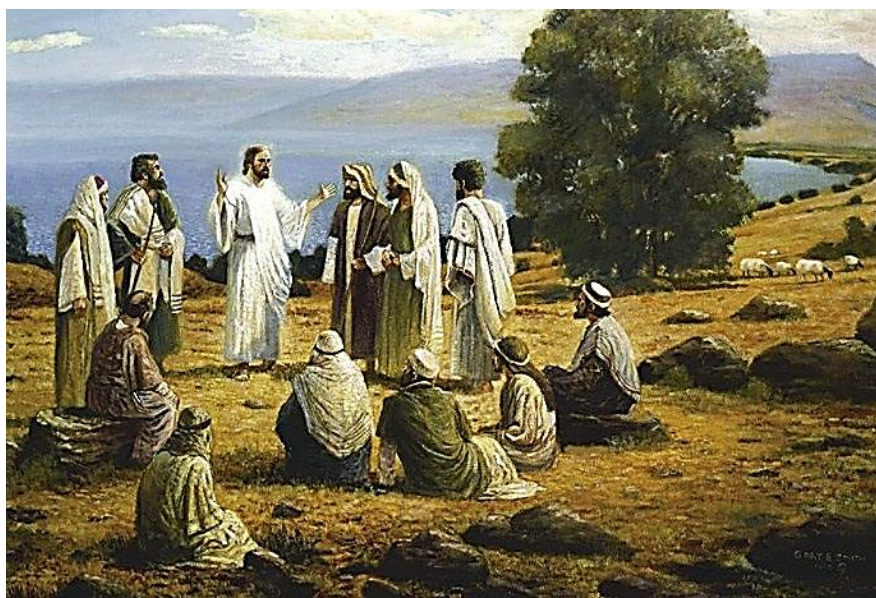


THE LESSONS FOR USE ON THE
 FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER ~ YEAR B
 Psalm 23 • Acts 4:5-12
 Current Series: 1st Corinthians

WE AFFIRM THE FOLLOWING:

- The Holy Trinity of God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- God has revealed Himself fully and decisively in Holy Scripture. We believe the Bible, consisting of the Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God and our guide for faith and life.
- There is only one way to Salvation - through Jesus Christ.
- The sanctity of human life based on our creation in the image of God and our election by God for service in His Kingdom. This leads us to respectfully affirm the sanctity of life at every stage, from conception to ordinary death.

EASTERTIDE CONTINUES....

Easter Weekend was weeks ago, but not the Season of Easter. For Christians who are part of a Church like ours that follows the traditional liturgical calendar, we are in the season of Eastertide.

Eastertide begins with Resurrection Sunday and ends with the Feast of Pentecost. This season has 50 days during which we celebrate the multiple appearances of our Risen Lord and his earthly ministry before his Ascension and the advent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Over the next four weeks, we'll continue recounting Our Lord's appearances to his followers.

MOUNTAINTOP MEETING IN GALILEE

After partaking of his last Passover, Jesus told his eleven disciples (Judas was betraying Him at the time) as they walked toward the Garden of Gethsemane, "But after I have been raised, I will go before you into Galilee" (Matthew 26:32, see also Mark 14:28). The Bible records this meeting did occur, recounting in Matthew 28:16-20

16 The eleven disciples went to the mountain in Galilee where Jesus had told them to go. 17 When they saw him, they bowed down in worship, though some had doubts. 18 When Jesus came near, he spoke to them. He said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 So wherever you go, make disciples of all nations: Baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. 20 Teach them to do everything I have commanded you. "And remember that I am always with you until the end of time."

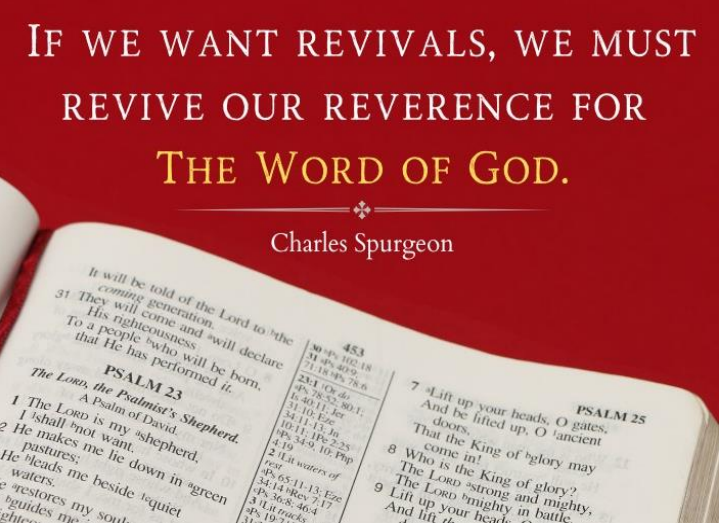

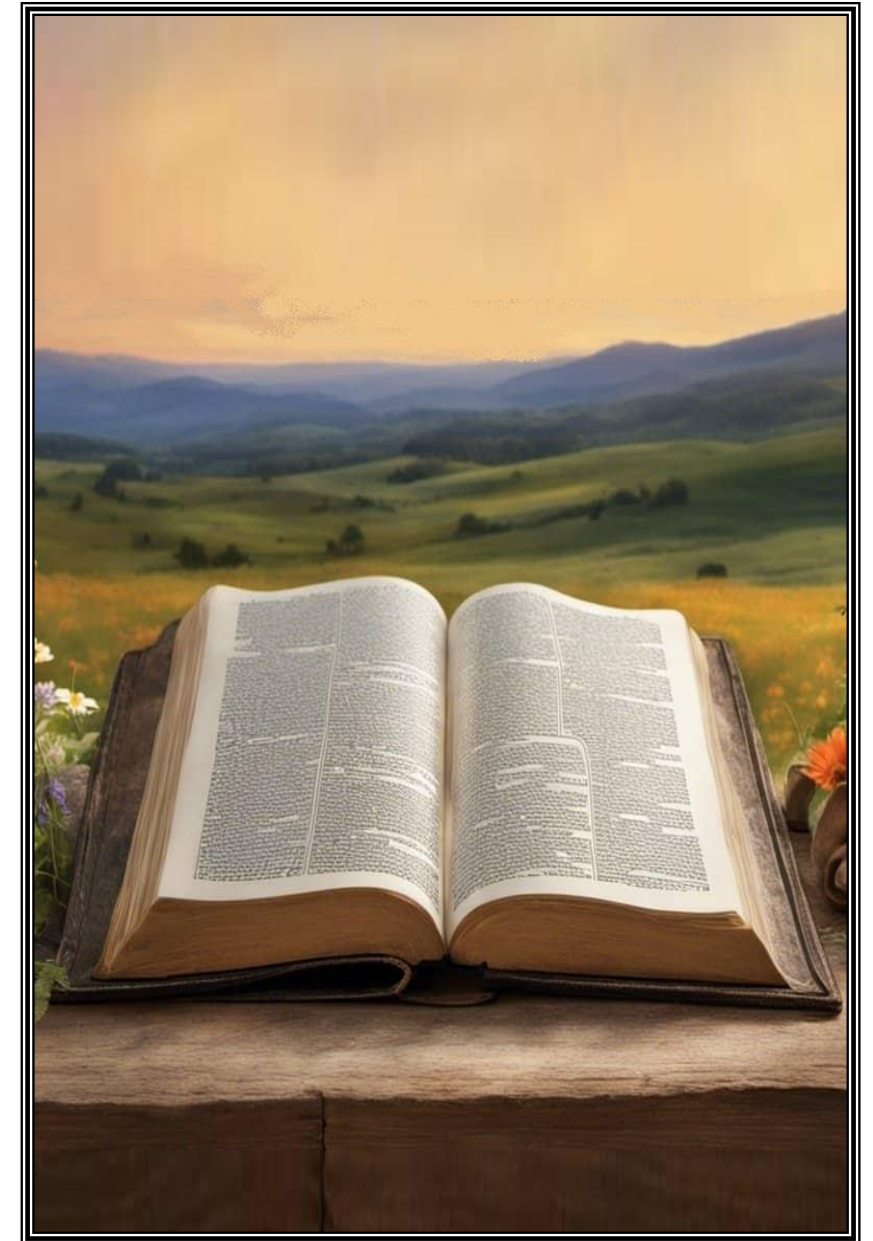
