ANY CHRISTIANS think of Easter as a one-day affair. It is a day for dressing up in new clothes for church, singing joyful ■ songs in worship, and going to a relative's house for Easter dinner afterward. But, what many do not understand is that Easter is not just one day or one weekend; it is a whole season. A season that lasts a full 50 days, from Resurrection Sunday till the Day of Pentecost, making it the longest season in the liturgical year, longer than both Christmas or Lent. And that's a good thing because a season like Eastertide helps to remind us of the most central tenant of our faith the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Celebrating Easter for fifty days is not duplicating Easter Sunday fifty times over. Instead, it is taking time to reflect upon and delight in the truth of Easter and its implications for our lives. Easter's essential truth is simple - it is this: CHRIST IS RISEN! HE IS RISEN, INDEED! Yet the Resurrection has more implications than we can adequately ponder in one day. Of course, in one sense, every Sunday is a kind of Easter. That's why we Christians worship on Sunday rather than Saturday, after all. So why do we need a separate season to reflect upon what we should think about every week?" My answer is that many of us forget the Easter dynamic of weekly Sunday worship. Setting aside a season to focus on the meaning of the Resurrection doesn't deny the importance of weekly Sunday worship. In fact, it can enhance it, drawing to the forefront something we know but may easily forget. So again this year, I invite you to join me in the richness and joy of a full fifty-day Eastertide celebration, one that allows us to think deeply and to pray broadly about what the Resurrection of Jesus means, both to us and to our world as we count down the days from our commemoration of the miracle of the empty tomb until we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

What celebrating Eastertide might involve?

- You could meditate on what the resurrection says about the character of Jesus Christ. (Psalm 16:10; Acts 2:25-28)
- You might ponder the fact that death has been swallowed up in victory. (1 Corinthians 15:54-56)
- You could reflect upon the fact that the power that raised Jesus from the dead is available in your life. (Ephesians 1:15-23)


